

1. ABOUT WOMBULU PRIVATE SCHOOL (WPS)

- Wombulu Private School (WPS) is an independent Grade 11 tutorial and examination centre, situated in Nakayale Village, Ombalantu, Omusati Region.
- The school has been approved by the Ministry of Education, Arts and Culture. Hence, it operates in accordance with the constitution of the Republic of Namibia, and governed by the Education Act 3 of 2020.
- WPS offers: Oshindonga/Oshikwanyama 1st Language, English as a 2nd Language, Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Geography, History, Development Studies, Agricultural Science, Economics, Entrepreneurship, Business Studies and Accounting. Only **Development Studies, Entrepreneurship** and **Agricultural Science** may be taken for the first time.

2. IMPORTANT INFORMATION (should be read in conjunction with the school disciplinary policy).

- **NO CELLPHONES ARE ALLOWED FOR BOTH HOSTEL AND DAY LEARNERS!**
- Classes commence on **February 2, 2026**.
- Subject fee is paid in advanced. The fee is split into ten consecutive installments, from February to November, please note that the registration fee is not part of these installments.
- **Red WPS golf t-shirt, plain black trouser (no jeans), black socks and black school shoes MUST** be worn at all times. In winter, a black plain jacket or jersey and red beany may be worn.
- The timetable runs from Monday-Saturday (08:00-17:30). All lessons **MUST** be attended.
- Mondays to Thursdays are for classes. Fridays and Saturdays are set aside for compulsory tests and extra classes. Failure to attend classes or take tests may result in a meeting with parents.
- If a learner drops out of classes during the year, they must pay the full tuition fee to be eligible to sit for the final examination (NSSCO), regardless of their attendance.
- There are two types of assessments: Friday's test series to track learners, progress and mock examinations in August, to prepare learners for the October/November national examination (NSSCO).
- The school holds a **compulsory** annual prize-giving ceremony in October. Awards are based on learners' performance in the September mock examinations, participation in extramural activities, and behavior throughout the year. **All learners must attend.**
